The PJF Gold Star Family Education Program will honor the Pararescuemen who paid the ultimate sacrifice for our freedom and provide for those gone to soon. We know our fallen heroes would want a quality Education for their children. Our aim is to help the Pararescue families whose unmeasurable sacrifice cannot be calculated.

The cost of an Educational Program can be significant regardless of the stage in a student's life. We're here to help with the tuition that comes at the earliest stages of a child's scholastic journey, like Preschool, Tutoring and Prep school. We want to enable students to obtain an education they may not have access to otherwise.

Funding for this Program will come from, generous individual donors, corporate sponsors, like-minded organizations, and fundraising events. The Pararescue Foundation will be solely responsible in determining the amount of the funds that will be applied to each request for support.

FAQs

Who is eligible?

- The recipient must be a child of a USAF Pararescuemen who was either; killed in action, killed in training, is totally & permanently 100% disabled or gone to soon.

How will I receive the Funds?

- PJF will mail a check to the school a recipient is enrolled in at the time of request.

How to apply?

- Families wishing to apply for the PJF Gold Star Family Education Program will send an email to info@pj.foundation describing the need and request an application. The application will be reviewed by PJF staff to confirm eligibility and determine the amount to be granted.

How will I know if my application has been accepted and approved?

- Our PJF staff communicate with each applicant as expeditiously as possible. If you are found eligible by the reviewing committee, your notification will come by a letter/email. Instructions may also be given regarding additional steps regarding information about the school's financial aid office. Please note that checks will only be mailed directly to your school's Financial Aid or Bursar's Office and can only be endorsed by a school official.

Will this Program cover all my educational expenses?

- The PJF GSFEP is not designed to be all inclusive. In most cases, it will cover a portion of a student's tuition. The specific amount offered will depend on the individual student's need. We will also consider other financial aid that a family may be receiving.
